Re-Application for Residence 2008-2009

To: All SMC Residents

As our office prepares for a new admissions cycle, I would like to give all of our current students the chance to reapply to residence for the 2008-2009 academic term. Please note that re-admission is not automatic and decisions are based on a number of criteria including:

- Academic status and GPA;
- Dons' evaluations;
- Contribution to one's house, the college, university and/or external community.

To re-apply for residence next year simply submit this application form along with a \$500 reservation deposit, made out to USMC, by **Monday March 31st, 2008**. Your deposit is fully refundable until the last day of the current residence term (i.e. May 11th, 2008). After that a partial refund of \$250 will be provided until August 15th, 2008. After August 15th 2008 the deposit is not refundable.* Students who still have unpaid residence fees on ROSI must clear their accounts before their applications will be processed.

Formal offers of residence will be sent by email once grades are available from UofT (usually late-May/early June). NB: Offers will be sent to the email address you provide on this application form. If your summer contact information changes after submitting this application, please be sure to inform our office directly.

* Please note that we reserve the right to cancel applications from those who fall short of our academic minimums or who receive a negative evaluation from their Don at year's end; in such situations, students will be given a full refund on their reservation deposit.

To be eligible for residence you must be a full time UofT student in good academic standing; you are also expected to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. Those with GPA's below 2.0 but above 1.49 are still eligible to reapply, but if admitted, must agree to obtain academic counseling from their Registrar's Office; they will also be a lower priority for re-admission than students who meet the 2.0 expectation. Those with GPA's below 1.5 are not considered to be in good academic standing and are therefore not eligible for residence. Students whose low academic performance was directly related to a health/personal problem, which can be verified in writing by a health care professional, may make a special appeal to the Dean of Students for readmission; exemptions will only be considered if space permits. Please note that by submitting this application, you authorize the Dean's office to access any academic records necessary to verify your eligibility for residence.

In such cases room assignments will be based on the following factors: (1) house and room last year (with priority given to incumbents); (2) seniority in the residence; (3) GPA; (4) Don's evaluation; (5) extra-curricular activities.

When making your house and room selections please keep the following in mind: (1) almost all double rooms will be used as such; (2) the renovations to the Historic Houses will be completed this summer and will therefore be available next year; (3) there will be a \$300 premium for rooms in Sorbara Hall and the newly renovated Historic Houses.
